Nizhny Novgorod, Russia	44	2	The old city in the top part of Volga. Nizhny Novgorod is the third largest city in Russia. It was closed to foreigners during Soviet times.
Vladimer, Russia	7	2	One of the most ancient cities of Russia. Vladimir was the capital of Russia in 1157-1439 and the center of the Russian Orthodoxy.
Kazan, Russia	15	2	Kazan is located on the Volga river. With a population nearing 1.2 million the city is made up of 77 different ethnic groups. It is the city of deep Muslim traditions and the center of the Russian Moslem.
Samara, Russia	20	2	Samara is located on the eastern side of European Russia, the biggest city on the Volga river. Population 1.2 million. The center of space manufacture in Russia.
Ural Mountains			Eastern Europe and Northern Asia are divided by a chain of mountains stretching for 1,500 miles.
Ekaterinburg, Russia	216	6	Fourth of the largest cities of Russia - about 1.4 million. The center of large mechanical engineering.
Chelyabinsk, Russia	49	2	Chelyabinsk - capital of Southern Ural. Population - 1.1 million.
Perm, Russia	19	2	Population - 1 million. The city occupies territory of 799 sq.km., conceding in Russia only to Moscow.
Ufa, Russia	28	2	The capital of Bashkortostan Republic.
Central Asia			Five countries of the Central Asia are former republics of Soviet Union.
Alma-Ata, Kazakhstan	70	2	Kazakhstan is Northwest of China is almost four times the size of Texas. Historically the Silk Way (from China to Europe) went through territory of Kazakhstan. One of the most advanced and democratic countries of Eurasia.
Tashkent, Uzbekistan	38	2	Uzbekistan is located North of Afganistan. The age of Tashkent is more than 2000. The age of second of the largest cities of Uzbekistan - Samarkad - is more than 3000. 90 % of Uzbeks are muslims.
Ashkhabad, Turkmenistan	15	2	Turkmenistan borders Caspian Sea and is between Iran and Kazakhstan. The most part of territory is desert. The most difficult place for annunciation in Eurasia. The majority of disciples sat 3 and more days in prison because of preaching.
Bishkek, Kyrgyzstan	12	2	Kyrgyzstan is West of China and is slightly smaller than South Dakota. The most part of territory is mountains and lakes.
Dushanbe, Tajikistan	7	2	Tajikistan is West of China. Since 1991 there has been 3 changes in Gov't and a 5 year civil war. One of the poorest states of Eurasia.

Volgograd, Russia	46	2	Volgograd is located 671 miles (1073 km) south of Moscow and is situated on the Volga river. The inhabitants of Volgograd are a freedom-loving people who have throughout history have gone to arms to defend their native homeland.
Rostov-na-Donu, Russia	115	2	Rostov-na-Donu is known as "the Gateway to the Caucasus" and is located in SE European Russia. Population: 1 million.
Yaroslavl, Russia	10	2	1000-anniversary in 2010. 266 kilometers from Moscow. The population is 600,000.

Kyiv, Ukraine	1912	31	1500 years old. Ancient center of Russia. There is a legend that apostle Andrew preached in Kiev. Population is 4 million. 2,000 disciples.
Odessa, Ukraine	397	5	Health resort city on the shore of Black sea. Population is 1.2 million.
Kharkov, Ukraine	140	4	More than 350 years old. Population is 1.5 million people. Largest commercial city in Ukraine. Over 40 universities and institutions.
Dnepropetrovsk, Ukraine	62	2	The principal commercial and industrial center of East Ukraine. This year is the 10th anniversary for the church. Population is 1 million.
Lvov, Ukraine	60	2	The ancient city, known as "second Paris" because of its beautiful architecture. The largest city of West Ukraine. Before WWII this city was part of Poland.
Donetsk, Ukraine	42	2	City of metallurgist and miners. 1.8 million population. The worst ecological zone in Ukraine. The shortest term of life in the country.
Vinnitsa, Ukraine	15	2	Historical center of SW Ukraine with a population of 350 thousand. In WWII, German HQ of East because of special strategic and mystical value.
Zaporozhye, Ukraine	7	0	Zaporozh'e - located in SE the part of Ukraine near the Dnepr River with population of 900 thousand. The center of metallurgy. It has the largest river island in Europe.
Chishinev, Moldova	81	2	The capital of Moldova (Moldova is located between the Ukraine and Romania). Populations is 700 thousand with 6 major nationalities. The church has 81 disciples.
